I wanted to pass along some ideas for you on how you can engage with and encourage your child to dig into God's Word this week! (Coming soon, you'll have access to an app with family devotions!!) In the meantime, may I encourage you to:

- Read this week's Bible passages together and discuss (Genesis 25:19-26; 27:1-41). If your child can read, encourage them to look up and find the passage themselves and read aloud to you.
- Have your child journal the verses most meaningful to them (or draw them, depending on age of child) and discuss.
- **Ask:** What did this Bible passage make you think about? Do you think that God answers prayer? Can you think of a prayer that God has answered for you either recently or in the past? What is something you are praying for God to answer now? Do you trust Him to answer in His perfect way and timing? Did Rebekah? What kind of plans does God have for you? What promises does He give us when we pray? (see: Jeremiah 29:11-13)
- Pray together.
- Review the Faith Verse together. 1 Thessalonians 5:24: God will make this happen, for He who calls you is faithful.
