

Light House Fine Arts Collective Policies & Procedures

Our Mission and Vision:

The mission of the Light House Fine Arts Collective is to bring glory to God through the fine arts, educating and enriching the lives of home-educated children in our community. We seek to provide students a space to worship, create and learn in a supportive environment. We have hired qualified teachers with a passion for the fine arts and many years of experience to bring your family excellent classes. We hope that they will be inspired and equipped through these classes to use their creativity and talents to glorify the Lord.

Parental Responsibilities:

- We ask that you commit to a full semester. Your teachers have planned, prepared and purchased materials for the classes, and we ask that you honor your commitment. As such, there will be no refunds if you decide to withdraw for any reason.
- In addition, the Collective classes are being offered as a full day schedule, and are not a la carte. As such, we have worked hard to make sure they are priced fairly for families. Therefore, we are asking for a full day commitment from all students.
- We strive to keep a healthy environment for our students. Please keep sick children at home. If your child has had a fever, been vomiting or had diarrhea, or has had a persistent cough within 24 hours of class, please do not send them.
- We are not a cooperative, so parents are not required to stay on site. We prefer
 that children be dropped off for class to minimize disruptions in our space. Please
 be assured, all adults working with your children have been through background
 checks.

- Your childrens' teachers would appreciate knowing if any accommodations are required for your child's learning, medical needs or behavior in class. Please communicate that information via email to: finearts@lhcag.org
- Please arrive on time. Devotions will begin promptly at 8:45 a.m. Students may begin arriving by 8:30 a.m. and must be picked up promptly at 1:45 at the end of the day.
- Pricing for the full day of classes is \$110/month for the first child and \$80/month for each additional child. Payment may be made in person by check, cash or credit/debit card.
- Please note there will be a supply fee of \$50 per student per semester.
- Payment for classes will be collected on a monthly basis, and will be due the first
 week of the month at drop-off. There will be no refunds issued for any reason.
 Classes missed because of illness, vacation, etc. will not be refunded or offered
 a make-up unless the absence is on the part of the instructor. A make-up day
 may be offered in the event of cancellation due to inclement weather. Your
 signature on the final page of this document indicates that you agree to these
 responsibilities and will abide by them.
- Light House Church is not responsible for any personal items lost or stolen, so please only send what your child needs for class each week.
- Please do not call the church office for any inquiries or information about class.

Student Responsibilities

- We expect students to behave in a way that honors the Lord and ask that you treat others the way you want to be treated (Matthew 7:12).
- Please come ready to learn, engage, create, and participate with a good attitude.
 There may be things you are asked to try (i.e. sing, try a new art technique, etc.)
 that may be uncomfortable at first. All we ask is that you have a happy heart and
 make a good effort.
- Students are expected to make every effort to participate in any outside performances beyond regular Wednesday classes. We realize this may not always be possible, however we ask that you make this a priority.
- Disruptive and/or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated. If a student is asked more than three times to correct their behavior but refuses, they will not be allowed to attend class in the future. No refund will be given.
- Students are required to arrive prepared for class with all needed supplies. (See supply list below.)
- Students must clean up after themselves.
- Damage done to any property belonging to the church or the Collective must be reported immediately and will need to be resolved by those held responsible.

- For safety and security purposes, students must stay ONLY in designated class area(s) throughout the entirety of the class day. Students are not allowed outside the building without supervision.
- Please do not bring any toys, noisy items, or anything that could be considered dangerous or distracting to class.
- Please dress modestly and appropriately. For art class, you may want to consider purchasing an art smock or bringing a large t-shirt to cover clothing.
- Cell phones are allowed, but must be kept on silent and out of sight unless special permission is given by the teaching team. They may be used in the event of an emergency. If cell phones prove to be a distraction, they will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day at pick up.
- Students must sign at the bottom of this document, indicating that they agree to abide by the policies and procedures.

- Snack **and** Lunch (These will not be provided)
- Water bottle (twist or snap cap, no open containers please)
